YOUTH HERITAGE PROJECT


The Youth Heritage Project (YHP) is an annual four-day, hands-on, interactive field school that brings together high school students, teachers, and mentors from across the state and provides an opportunity for participants to experience how preservation and conservation work in the real world. YHP inspires future generations to steward Washington State's unique historic and natural resources and culminates in a Town Hall-style meeting with 200+ guests in attendance as students present their preservation strategies and ideas to the public and a panel of thought leaders.

HISTORIC OUTDOORS

Building on our Youth Heritage Project, we are teaming up with Boys/Girls Outdoor Leadership Development (BOLD/GOLD) of YMCA Seattle to offer this new program. Historic Outdoors takes youth to historic places in remote areas to learn about conservation and preservation. The program will help them think critically about how these philosophies can work together to protect both natural and cultural resources in the wilderness.


SANTA AT THE MANSION
